Program description

The Spanish major provides a base of knowledge in language, literature, culture, film, translation studies, and professional and medical Spanish that can prepare you for exciting careers and open many doors. The sequence of courses will lead to Senior Capstone on a research topic that fascinates you, along with personalized mentoring for it. The major concentration in Spanish consists of a minimum of 21 upper-division semester hours of coursework and a maximum of 42 credit hours. The low 21 credit hours requirement of the Spanish major provides students with the possibility of combining it with another major such as Premed, Education, Nursing, or minor in such areas as Women, Gender & Sexuality Studies or English, among many other options. Spanish courses can also be taken during the summer in our Teacher-Led Study Abroad Programs to Costa Rica, Perú or Puerto Rico. The mission of the Spanish program is to cultivate appreciation and respect of other cultures, sensitivity to issues of social justice, the ability to communicate well with the people of those cultures in their language as well as to demonstrate the practical aspect of combining Spanish for all professional endeavors.
